## ABOUT THE AGARWALS

## RULES / REQUIREMENTS

A maximum of two teams can participate from each college

The participating team should produce a letter of permission from the Principal or the HOD

The participants should carry with them their college ID cards

The participating team can choose any scene from any play of Shakespeare

The number of participants per team could be from 5 to 10  
Same person cannot be a participant in two teams

A team is allowed three minutes to appear on the stage to begin, and 10 to 15 minutes for performance

The participants should report at the Saheli Auditorium in the campus before 9:30 a.m.

The Registration Form should reach the HOD, English, on or before January 30, 2019
